3. There will be up to two individuals chosen each year based on their application, stated officiating goals, potential to serve Board #111 in the future and whether they have previously attended a school / camp before. (Preference would be given to first time attendees.
4. The amount of each scholarship would be equal to one half of the school / camp tuition, but could never exceed \$175.
5. Recipients must show proof of completion and receipt of payment from the school / camp to the Board #111 Interpreter upon their return, to receive their scholarship reimbursement.
6. The Board #111 Education Committee will recommend the selected individual(s) with final approval being given by Board #111's Board of Directors.
