

Background Check Policy

1. In order for an official to work any games assigned by IAABO Board 111, they must have on file with the IAABO Board 111 Secretary, a current and valid State of Maine Criminal History Records Check (CHRC) form indicating the Maine Department of Education's approval to serve in Maine Schools.

~~**Exception 1:** For the 2015-16 season current members will be allowed to officiate once they have shown proof to the IAABO Board 111 Secretary, that they have applied for their Maine Criminal History Records Check (CHRC) and IAABO Board 111 has done a Sex Offender Registry Check.~~

~~**Exception 2:** Board 111 will accept the employment verification for active full time certified law enforcement officers (LEO). LEO must submit a letter from the respective Agency within 30 days of email notice by Board 111 secretary certifying that they are actively serving as a law enforcement officer in good standing. Any current LEO leaving the field must comply prior to the next basketball season with the DOE background check.~~

~~2. Perspective officials and new members who transfer to Board 111 are allowed to officiate once they provide their Maine CHRC to Board 111 Secretary or have shown proof they have applied for the Maine Criminal History Records Check (CHRC) and IAABO Board 111 has done a Sex Offender Registry Check. They will have up to one year to complete the process.~~

~~3. Beginning in 2020-21 season all law enforcement officers must have on file a current and valid State of Maine Criminal History Records Check (CHRC) form indicating the Maine Department of Education's approval to serve in Maine Schools.~~

2. Effective August 1, 2019 each Member Official shall obtain and maintain a Criminal History Record Check (CHRC) approval from the Maine Department of Education. Once the Certification Office receives the criminal history record information and clears the application, a five-year eard-on line certificate will be issued
